Description: Inflatable man, Evaporating Woman is a collaborative duet in which Lindsey and Jason Dietz Marchant explore the point where their unique identities merge, trying to find the moment that exists outside of their individual control. Through this journey they grapple with the recognition that there is sometimes emptiness where one hoped for something more; that the imperfect and messy workings of life are full of unexpected pauses. The duo finds them-selves abandoned and unafraid to hit the ground hard. They rely on the precarious catches of a complex partnership whose strength lies not in power or force but in a balance held together by a fragile thread. Navigating what it means to exploit and explode the interior workings of a long-term relationship; a vocabulary of fearlessly flung bodies is juxtaposed with the inherent vulnerability accessible in such a partnership.

Any Given Day

Description: Any Given Day is a duet that uses movement, text, and music to explore the complexity of a couple's daily routine. The audience witnesses these two old friends caught in the chaos of miscommunication lined with good intentions. The dance evokes a sense of humor and compassion for the characters and the dilemmas the various miscommunications put them in. Deconstructing what has just been built, there is a gradual dehumanization of these characters that allows us to examine the issues of the objectification of the body in both male and female roles within relationships and the voluntary relinquishing of ones sense of self into such roles. At the heart of the piece is the inciting of the audience to laugh along with the performers at the absurdity of some of our most common concerns and scenarios in the game of love. We also then proceed to open the door to tempt a journey which would allow us to witness the cruelty between one another and to ourselves in these same moments and the sadness that ultimately sets in. The final moments of the piece revisit the idea that we should never forget that our ability to laugh at ourselves is perhaps the most important step in finding a deeper awareness.

Length: The current running time of this piece varies from 14 minutes to 17 minutes. Past performances, such as those listed below had the running time at this piece vary from 8 minutes to 20 minutes during different incarnations of the work.
